"To deem or not to deem"

Deeming, means declaring that your stroke has been played without actually touching the ball.

It is useful when:

- The ball is already in the perfect tactical position.
- The ball needs to stay where it is so that your partner can manoeuvre into a better position.
- The ball needs to stay where it is so that an opponent has to return from a good position.
- The ball is hampering an opponent from playing their optimum shot.
